

KELLY SCHULTZ MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

DESCRIPTION

Kelly Schultz began his career as a Union Pipefitter and eventually became an integral part of the project management team at RMF Nooter (NOOTER). Kelly embodied the type of employee that NOOTER strives to retain. He had a unique way of serving the customers' needs while keeping NOOTER's best interests in mind and treating craftsmen with respect. With his positive attitude and bright smile, Kelly was an expert in the field of industrial construction as well as a beloved member of the NOOTER family. The Kelly Schultz Memorial Scholarship has been established to honor Kelly, who lost his fight to cancer in 2014 at the age of 42.

WHO MAY APPLY

- Individual pursuing a career in construction management or mechanical engineering at The University of Toledo or Bowling Green State University.
- Undergraduate in at least the second of a four or five year degree program at one of the listed universities.
- Minimum grade point average of 2.5 (out of 4.0).
- U.S. citizen.

REQUIREMENTS

- Submit a completed NOOTER Scholarship Application
- Submit a 1 – 3 page essay that answers 3 of the following:
 - Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?
 - Who or what inspired you to pursue a career in the construction industry?
 - Pick an experience from your own life and explain how it has influenced your development.
 - How would you change or improve the construction industry?
 - Describe how you have demonstrated leadership ability in your school, work, or community.
- Submit a current transcript from the schools attended thus far.
- Submit a current resume.
- Submit 1 letter of recommendation (letter cannot be from an applicant's immediate family).

APPLICATION DEADLINE AND AWARD

- All application materials, including the required application, transcript, resume, and essay, must be sent as one file and emailed to Casey Kessler at ckessler@nooter.com by April 14, 2024.
- Appearance and completeness will be considered during evaluation. There is a point system for each section of the application. If a section is left blank, the applicant receives zero points for that section.
- The \$1,500 scholarship winner will be notified on May 6, 2024.

CONFIDENTIALITY OF APPLICATIONS

Information on the applications will be retained in confidence and used for no purpose other than this competition. Applications will be destroyed by NOOTER after they are no longer necessary records. Applications and transcripts will not be returned.
